To Citizenship and Immigration Canada:

Union of Persian Students and Human Rights Activists in Exile is an international non-governmental organization which follows the manifest of **United Front of Iranian Students**.

Based on information gathered by Iranian Students Organizations first-hand and from well-known international human rights organizations as well as the Department of State, the Iranian government continues to be a major abuser of human rights with no evidence of improvement. Systematic abuses include extra-judicial killings and summary executions, widespread use of torture and other degrading treatment, arrest and detention, lack of fair trials, and harsh prison conditions (DOS Human Rights Report: Iran).

This is to certify Mr. **Mustafa Sha'bani** has converted his religion from Islam to Christianity and it is a Apostasy In Islam and Islamic Republic of Iran.

According to the information which we have gotten from Iran we recommend a couple important points as the follow:

During thirty three years, Iranian regime has executed many people who have converted their religion from Islam to other religions and or even it sentenced to death many religious minority among them Baha'i, Christian and Sunnite. The Iranian regime has announced the Christianity in Iran is a political-security offense.

In April 2005, the *Globe and Mail* reported on two cases where Iranian deportees from Canada were subjected to mistreatment when they returned to Iran, and in one case the returnee "died after receiving 100 lashes in prison" (2 Apr. 2005). In the other case, a female student activist was detained for 26 hours and "was struck in the face and head twice while in prison when she refused to sign a document denouncing Canada" (*Globe and Mail* 2 Apr. 2005).

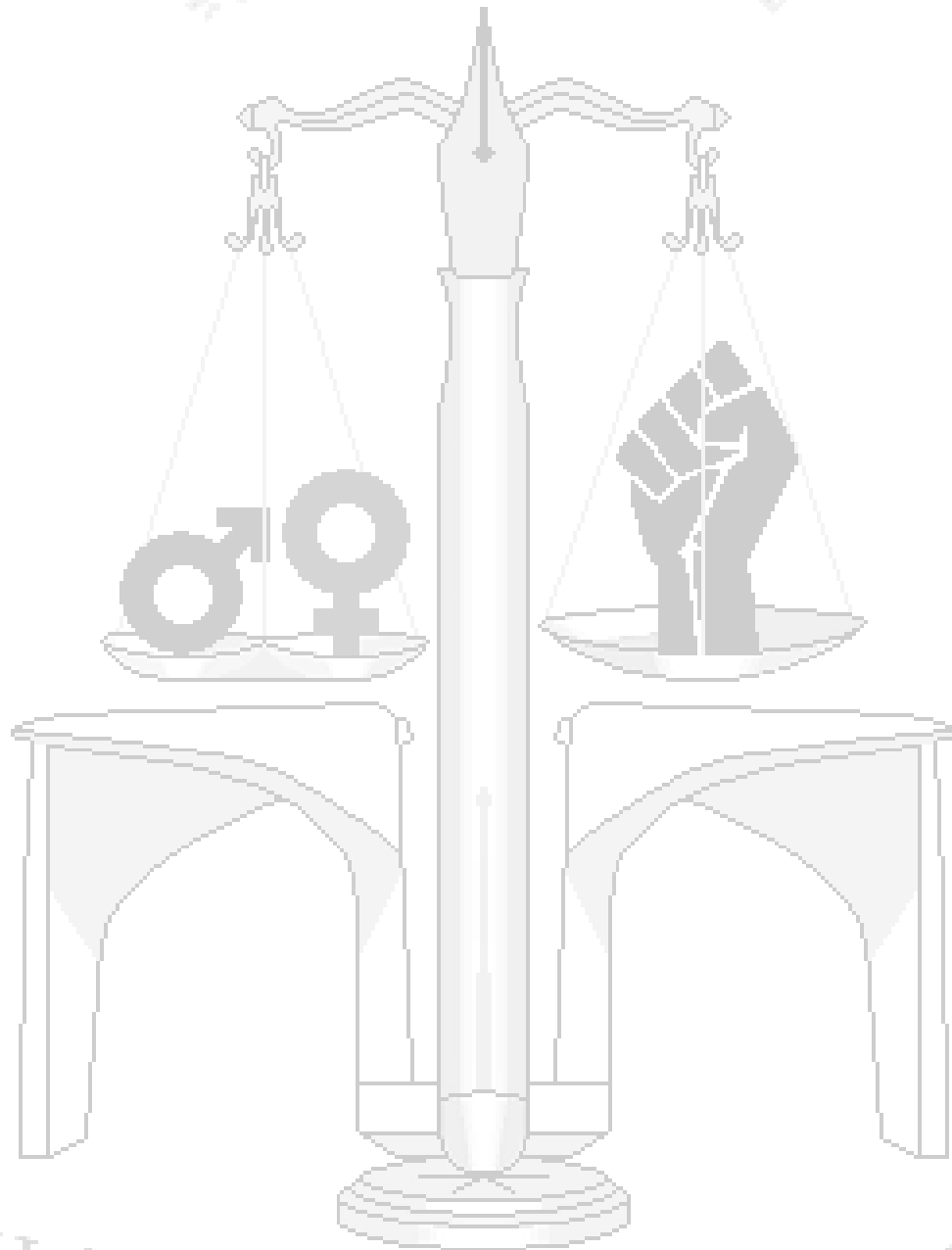
